RULES & REGULATIONS

2012 SEASON

This is your pool! Please keep it clean and obey the Rules and Regulations. They have been established for your safety and comfort!

SAFETY AND HEALTH POLICIES:

1. Lifeguards are responsible for controlling **ALL** pool activities at all times. **LIFEGUARDS ARE ON DUTY TO PROTECT AND ASSIST YOU.** Those not following the directives of lifeguards must exit the pool or leave the property as directed by the lifeguard or pool manager. Repeatedly disobeying their directions, infractions of established rules and regulations or general misconduct by you, members of your family **OR YOUR GUESTS** can result in graduated disciplinary action up to and including suspension or revocation of membership privileges.
2. No running inside pool area.
3. Only one person is allowed on the diving board at a time.
4. Children under 12 **MUST** be accompanied and supervised by a parent or another responsible individual. Children cannot be left unattended in the pool area while parents, guardian or other responsible person use other club facilities (ie. tennis courts). The safety and conduct of all children using club facilities other than the swimming pools (playground, tennis courts, shuffleboard, etc.) are the responsibility of parents or other responsible individual.
5. Any child requiring diapers or training pants **MUST** wear vinyl pants while swimming in **EITHER** pool. It is the sole responsibility of the parent, guardian or other adult in attendance with the child to comply with this policy. For detailed information related to this policy, see the flyer inside this mailing and the posters throughout the club.
6. Non-swimmers are prohibited from entering the deep areas of the pool. Children under 12 **MUST** pass a water test and wear a tag permitting them to swim without an adult in the deep and diving areas of pool. A child under 12 who does not possess a tag may swim in the deep areas of the pool only if a supervising adult is swimming with him or her within an arm's reach.
7. Children under 5 must be accompanied in either pool by an adult practicing touch supervision. This means that the adult is within an arm's reach of the child at all times.
8. **NO** floatation devices or swim aids are allowed in either pool.
9. No alcoholic beverages are permitted on premises, with the exception of special events as approved by the Board of Governors. Persons under the influence of intoxicants will be denied entrance to the pool or told to leave the club. Any person (member or guest) who is found with alcohol on the property will be requested to leave immediately. This includes members, guests and any and all family members of those involved. No guest fees will be refunded. Any violations of this policy may result in suspension of privileges up to and including revocation of membership.
10. Smoking is prohibited on the entire property. This includes the parking lot area.
11. Parking will be permitted on club property **ONLY**. Reckless driving on club property, including but not limited to spinning wheels, shall result in a one week suspension for the operator or owner (if the operator cannot be identified). Before reinstatement, restitution for any and all damages must be made.

12. Eating and drinking is permitted at the snack bar or the grassy area only. Eating and drinking is not permitted on the pool deck.
13. Showering before entering the pool is highly recommended. You may be requested by the staff to take a shower prior to entering the pool.

MEMBERSHIP POLICIES:

14. Each dues-paying member shall be permitted **TWO** Radnor Township guests per year. (A family invited by a member is counted as “one guest.”) Infraction of this rule shall result in the following:
 1. 1st offense: Warning (Phone call to family by Mgt.)
 2. 2nd offense: Individual’s cards recalled for one week.
 3. 3rd offense: Family’s membership recalled for two weeks.
15. No individual who is a member of a family group or who would otherwise be privileged to hold either an active or associate membership may be admitted as a guest.
16. Babysitters, summer house guests and housekeepers may be admitted to the club as a member of the household that they are working for or staying with. The family **MUST** pay a membership fee for this person as if they were a part of the family. This membership is **NOT** part of the five member maximum rule.
17. Admission to the pool requires a valid membership card or identification. This rule will be strictly enforced. Violations, to include falsely presenting a guest as a family member, may result in suspension of membership privileges.
18. Prospective members on the Waiting List must come as guests of a current CSC member in good standing. This requirement may be waived at the discretion of the board, by special invitation only, during off peak periods.

OTHER CLUB POLICIES:

19. The Club has no facilities for checking valuables and shall not be held responsible for loss of personal property.
20. No amplified radios or other audio devices permitted. Earphones are acceptable.
21. Private parties will be allowed during non-operating hours during the time between Memorial Day and commencement of summer hours. The member/sponsor will be responsible for arranging and paying for the manager and the appropriate number of life guards. Events will run no later than 9:00 PM. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited. The member/sponsor will be responsible for clean-up. Maximum number of people at one event will be 100. The party must be approved by the Board prior to the party.

PLEASE ensure that ALL members of your family AND your guests are familiar with these rules and regulations!
